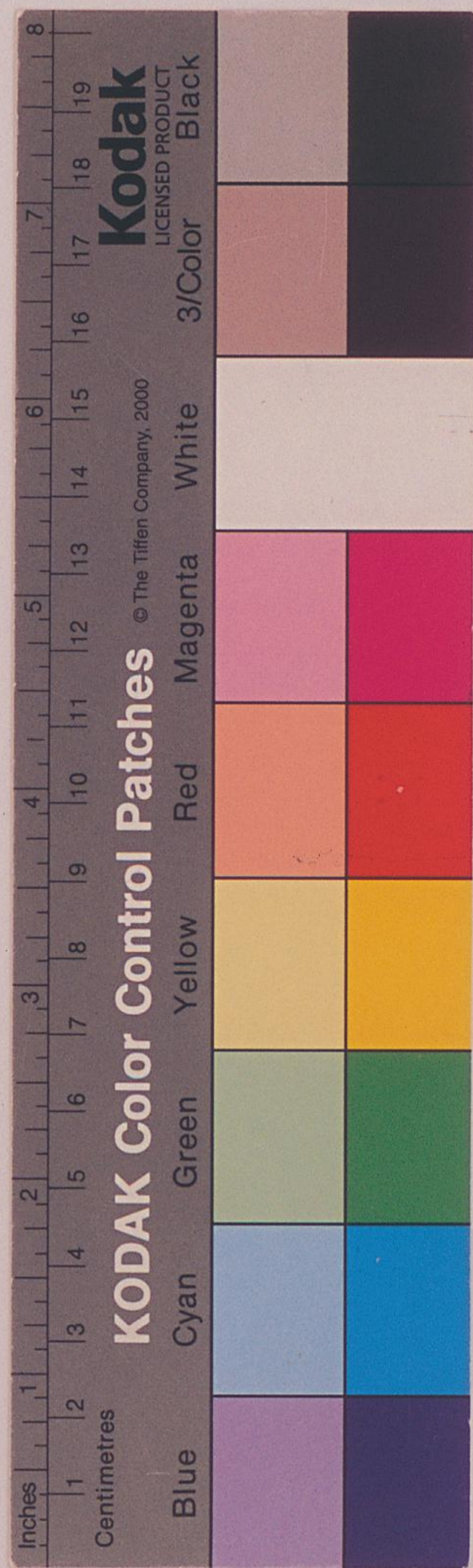
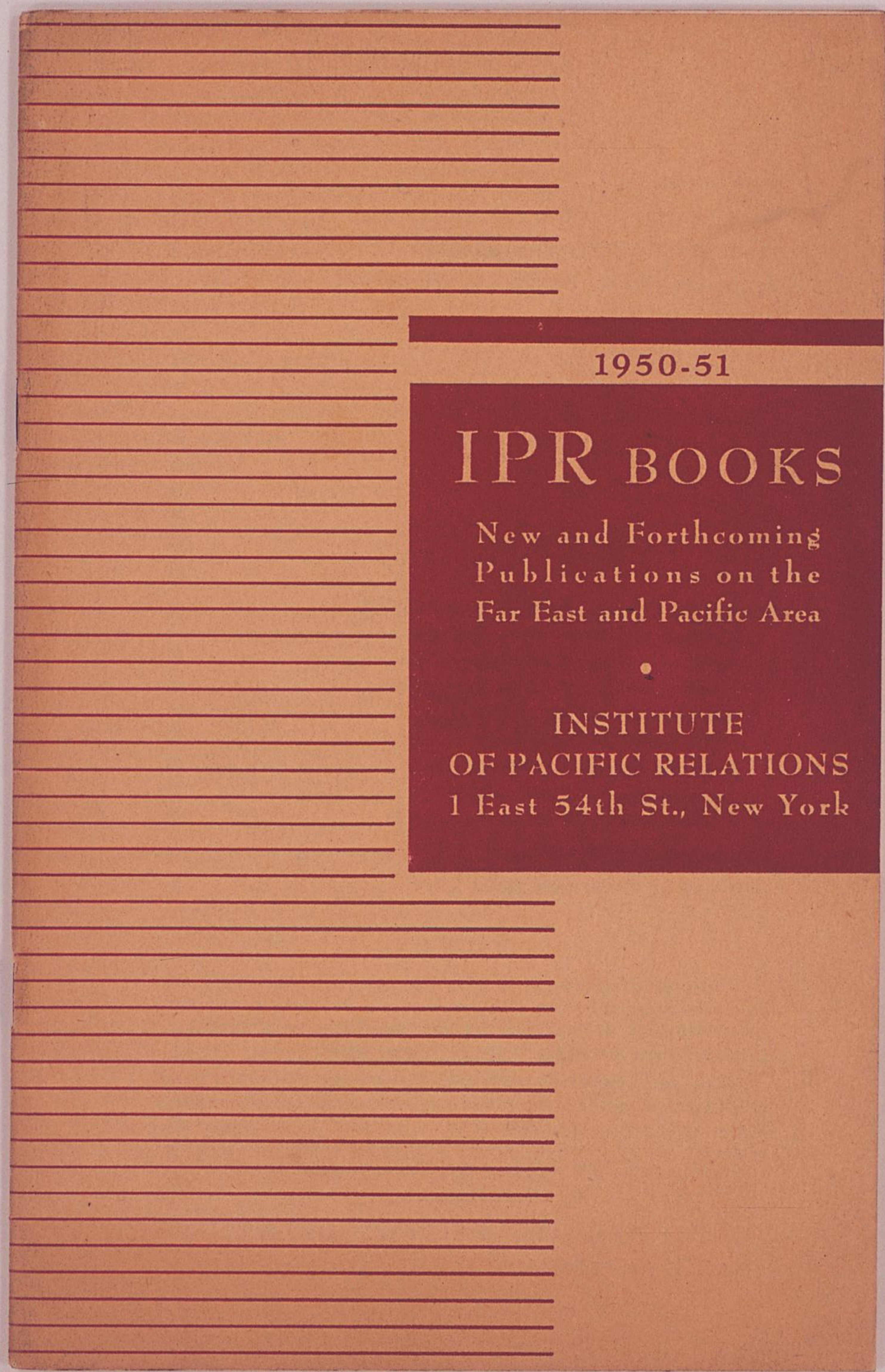

KOREA TODAY.

By George M. McCune. With the Collaboration
of Arthur L. Grey, Jr.

Cambridge: Harvard University Press. 1950. 372 pp. \$3.50

The first comprehensive account of political and economic developments in Korea since the end of World War II. It provides an analysis of the American and Russian military occupations, the efforts of the United Nations to deal with the problem of unification of the country, the political and economic policies followed in the southern and northern regimes, and an account of the American economic aid program in South Korea. A useful appendix of documents, tables, and bibliography, together with a note on Korean demography, is included.

THE OCCUPATION OF JAPAN: SECOND PHASE.

By Robert A. Fearey. With a Preface by Joseph
C. Grew

New York: The Macmillan Company. 1950. 240 pp. \$3.00

An authoritative, up-to-date survey of Japan's progress toward economic recovery and political autonomy, of particular importance in view of the increasing recognition of Japan's political, economic, and strategic role in the Far East today. This volume analyzing the major developments in the occupation of Japan from early 1948 to the middle of 1950 is intended to supplement the earlier IPR study, *The Allied Occupation of Japan* by Edwin M. Martin.

ASPECTS OF JAPAN'S LABOR PROBLEMS

By Miriam S. Farley, With a Supplement by William T. Moran

New York: The John Day Company. 1950. 272 pp. \$3.50

This concise survey describes the more significant developments in the Japanese labor movement between 1946 and 1950; its remarkable expansion was one of the truly striking phenomena in postwar Japan. Although this study must necessarily be regarded as an introductory survey of a large and complex problem which is bound to manifest important new changes in a fully sovereign Japan, this account suggests the great variety and fluidity of labor activity in Japan and the complexity of the problems which it raises for the future.

THE BEGINNINGS OF POLITICAL DEMOCRACY IN JAPAN

By Nobutaka Ike

Baltimore: The Johns Hopkins Press. 1950. 246 pp. \$3.50.

The origins, growth, and decline of the democratic movement which swept over Japan between 1875 and 1890 are described in this timely book. During these years, rapid changes were taking place in the old political, social, and economic structure and, the author reveals, a significant segment of the population indicated their desires to achieve democracy by joining and supporting a political movement of wide scope. The account of such events gives new meaning to the present programs for the democratization of Japan under the Occupation.

LAND UTILIZATION IN AUSTRALIA

This is a completely revised and up-to-date edition of the standard work in its field, first published in 1939.

THE LEFT WING IN SOUTHEAST ASIA

By Virginia Thompson and Richard Adloff

New York: William Sloane Associates. 1950. 298 pp. \$4.00

A factual, objective study of the political forces now at work in Indonesia, Burma, Malaya, Indochina, and Thailand. The authors first examine Southeast Asia as a whole, then the radical political groupings and the men who lead them in each of the five countries. They also trace the relationship of socialist and communist organizations in each country with the communist movements of the West.

HUMAN BONDAGE IN SOUTHEAST ASIA

By Bruno Lasker

Chapel Hill: University of North Carolina Press. 1950. 406 pp. \$6.00

A monumental study of the origins of the various forms of bondage in Southeast Asia, their present state and significance, and what has been done on both national and international levels to improve the situation, by the author of *Peoples of Southeast Asia* and *Asia on the Move*.

The Institute is an unofficial and non-partisan organization, founded in 1925 to facilitate the scientific study of the peoples of the Pacific area. It is composed of autonomous National Councils in the principal countries having important interests in the Pacific area, together with an International Secretariat. It is privately financed by contributions from National Councils, corporations and foundations. It is governed by a Pacific Council composed of members appointed by each of the National Councils.

In addition to the independent activities of its National Councils, the Institute organizes private international conferences every two or three years. Such conferences have been held at Honolulu (1925 and 1927), Kyoto (1929), Shanghai (1931), Banff, Canada (1933), Yosemite Park, California (1936), Virginia Beach, Virginia (1939), Mont Tremblant, Quebec (1942), Hot Springs, Virginia (1945), Stratford, England (1947), and Lucknow (1950). It conducts an extensive program of research on the political, economic and social problems of the Pacific area and Far East. It also publishes the proceedings of its conferences, a quarterly journal, *Pacific Affairs*, and a large number of scholarly books embodying the results of its studies.

Neither the International Secretariat nor the National Councils of the Institute advocate policies or express opinions on national or international affairs. Responsibility for statements of fact or opinion in Institute publications rests solely with the authors.
