Mr. INOUYE introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Armed Services

A BILL

To authorize an investigation relating to the restoration and preservation of certain cultural and historical artifacts of the Ryukyuan people.

1. Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
2. That the President is authorized and directed to conduct a full and complete investigation and study to determine (1) the extent to which cultural and historical artifacts of the Ryukyuan people were damaged or destroyed during World War II, (2) what can be done to restore and preserve those artifacts so damaged and destroyed, and (3) what contribution the United States should make to assist in such restoration and preservation. The President shall report to Con-

BILL

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, That section 101 of the Ryukyu Islands Reversion Law (Public Law No. 94-362, January 17, 1972) is amended as follows:

(1) Subsection (b) of section 101 is amended by striking "the Ryukyu Islands" and inserting "the Ryukyu Islands and the Okinawa Islands".

(2) Subsection (c) of section 101 is amended by striking "the Ryukyu Islands" and inserting "the Ryukyu Islands and the Okinawa Islands".

(3) Subsection (d) of section 101 is amended by striking "the Ryukyu Islands" and inserting "the Ryukyu Islands and the Okinawa Islands".
