Dear Mr. Togo:

In response to your letter of December 23, 1969, requesting information pertaining to military installations and sites presently utilized by the United States Armed Forces in Okinawa, I am enclosing herewith a listing of such facilities and a description of each facility by size in acres, mission, and location by grid reference to a map, five copies of which are also enclosed. The information contained on the list should be considered CONFIDENTIAL. The maps are not classified.

I believe that this information will provide you a better indication of the U.S. military facilities and areas in the Ryukyus than we were able to provide you in the case of the Bonins. As our own preparations for reversion consultations continue, we will be developing additional information and will pass on to you such as would be useful in your planning.
