TALKING PAPER

With respect (1) to your proposals for changes in wording in the Notes Verbale which would be exchanged in connection with a visit of an SSN to Japan and (2) your Statement which will accompany the release of the Notes and the U.S. Statement, we have the following comments:

1. Your proposal to delete "solely" and add "any" in the seventh line of the U.S. Note to the GOJ is acceptable to the USG.
2. Your proposal to delete "on ----, 1964" and the comma after "note" in the fifth and sixth lines of the GOJ Note to the USG is acceptable. Also your proposal to delete "United States nuclear-powered submarines" in the eighth and ninth lines, and add "SSNs" in the ninth line is acceptable to the USG.
3. With reference to your request for clarification of subparagraph 2H (claims), you are correct that the reference to SOFA is textually a departure from the standard U.S. Statement. You are aware that the Aide Memoire contains the statement that SOFA provisions regarding claims will continue to apply. Inclusion in the Statement is therefore consistent with the Aide Memoire and with the understanding of the two governments that the U.S. Statement is not intended to supercede SOFA provisions.
4. With respect to the draft GOJ statement which will be issued at the same time as the Notes Verbale and the U.S. Statement, we suggest that in the 3rd paragraph, add "or Polaris type" after "submarine" in

the fourth line. We also suggest revision of the third sentence of this paragraph as follows "The U.S. Government has on this occasion renewed its assurance that it has no intention of acting in a manner contrary to the wishes of the Government of Japan with respect to the matters involving prior consultation under the Security Treaty."

It seems better to us to make reference to Polaris parallel with the reference in the same sentence to Nautilus type submarines and this also avoids highlighting the type of weapons carried aboard any vessel.

Reference to prior consultation in connection with "deployment into Japan of nuclear weapons" is, as you know, part of the confidential record of discussions agreed with the GOJ at the time of the negotiation of the Security Treaty in 1959. We have been unable to find any unclassified public reference to this portion of the confidential understanding re. prior consultation and would therefore prefer that it not be released in connection with the entry of SSNs. Our suggested revision completes the quotation drawn from the Kishi-Eisenhower joint communique of January 19, 1960 and we also believe its use may assist you in public explanation of the position since it contains reference to prior consultation.
