LAND TRIBUNAL ESTABLISHED FOR RYUKYU ISLANDS

Legal questions concerning fair compensation and condemnation of land by the United States will henceforth be considered by a new forum to be known as the United States Land Tribunal for the Ryukyu Islands.

The new tribunal was established today under HICOM Ordinance No. 19 signed by Lt. General Donald P. Booth, United States High Commissioner of the Ryukyu Islands.

The ordinance abolished the USCAR Land Court and transferred all previous business of the court to the tribunal. The new forum will be composed of three members appointed for two years with provision for extension or removal by the Secretary of Defense, United States Government.

Abolition of the court and its replacement by a tribunal is expected to provide greater informality and speed in handling the many appeals pending before the old court. Establishment of the tribunal is a further step in the implementation of the land program mutually agreed between Ryukyuan and American representatives at the joint land conferences.

The High Commissioner announced appointment of two former Land Court judges as members of the new tribunal. They are Mac Alan Freitag who will be senior member of the forum and Marion B. Wilson as the second member. A third member will be appointed at a later date. Judge Irving Eisenstein of the old court is being assigned as chief of the legal division of the USCAR Legislative and Legal Department under Col. Albert Barkin, department director.

Principal questions to be considered by the tribunal will be determination of fair compensation for US-acquired land, all questions concerning land condemnation by US agencies in the Ryukyus, and interpretations of ordinances and laws implementing the new 1958 land program.
