ARTICLE X (A)

This Treaty shall remain in force until it is terminated by agreement between the Governments of Japan and the United States of America. It will be so terminated whenever there shall have come into force such United Nations arrangements as will satisfactorily provide for the maintenance of international peace and security in the Japan area. In that event all United States armed forces shall be withdrawn from Japan as soon as possible and in any case not later than 90 days after the Treaty is terminated.

However, after the Treaty has been in force for ten years, either Party may give notice to the other Party its intention to terminate the Treaty, in which case the Treaty shall terminate one year after such notice has been given and all United States armed forces shall be withdrawn by that time.

ARTICLE X (B)

After the Treaty has been in force for five years, or at any time thereafter, the Parties shall, if either of them so requests, consult together for the purpose of reviewing the Treaty, having regard for the factors then affecting peace and security in the Japan area, including the development of United Nations arrangements for the maintenance of international peace

An understanding on Article X (C)

It is understood that, besides the case envisaged in the first paragraph of Article X, the Treaty may be terminated at any time if the two Governments so agree.
